OUR NETWORK OF CITIES AND PARTNERS

In the summer of 2025, **32 cities and regions** from the European Union, Canada, and the United States joined the **EU Cities Gateway Program** through an open call. Together, they form the heart of the initiative — a vibrant cohort working across four thematic clusters through study visits, peer learning, and hands-on pilot projects.

But the Gateway does not stop there. Beyond this core group, the **EU Cities Gateway Community** brings together a wider circle of cities, regions, and institutions eager to exchange ideas and collaborate across the Atlantic.

Since 2017, more than **150 cities** across North America and Europe have taken part in EU-funded cooperation programs. Building on this experience, the Community reconnects with past participants and welcomes new partners – even in other regions of the world through the ongoing **International Urban and Regional Cooperation** (**IURC**) **programs in Latin America and Asia/Australasia.**

Members can join webinars, thematic events, and knowledge-sharing sessions, gaining access to new ideas, practical tools, and inspiring examples from their colleagues. They can also take part in selected in-person exchanges, connecting directly with experts and practitioners who are shaping the cities of tomorrow.
